The SEAL program aims to address the learning needs of gifted and high potential students who are capable of working at a significantly faster pace and in greater depth than peers of their own age.

Reservoir High is one of the few selected schools in the northern region to offer a SEAL Program and provide this opportunity to highly able and academic students.

SEAL at Reservoir

Reservoir High offers places to a limited number of very capable and committed students who feel that they would benefit from taking part in a curriculum acceleration program.

Suitable students will have academic skills above those of their peers and will be strongly motivated towards learning. Students taking part in the program may progress to VCE subjects after their third year at school.

Curriculum acceleration differs from the mainstream program in that it:

- Provides a faster paced curriculum with less repetition.
- Supports greater study of abstract, complex and in-depth concepts.
- Supports students to develop high level investigative, problem solving and creative thinking skills.
- Fosters a caring learning environment where students are challenged by their intellectual peers.

Scholarship Program

Entry at Year 7 — 2019

Reservoir High is proud to reward talented Grade 6 students who also display leadership and respect.

Academic Excellence Scholarships — \$300

These are awarded to students who have demonstrated an excellent academic record throughout their primary school studies.

Leadership and Citizenship Scholarships — \$300

These are awarded to students who have demonstrated leadership skills and been positive role models for their fellow students.

Sport Scholarships — \$300

These are awarded to students who can demonstrate excellence across at least two sports (one in exceptional circumstances) and have evidence of potential leadership in sport.

Performing Arts Scholarships — \$300

These are awarded to students who can demonstrate excellence in Performing Arts eg. dance, vocals, instruments.
